

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Below are the terms and conditions of your booking agreement. Please read them carefully. When you sign the booking form, you (and any other person on whose behalf you book) agree to accept all of these conditions, and you acknowledge that you have read the relevant trip information. You also agree that the information given by you on the booking form and medical information form is complete and true. A contract will exist as soon as we receive your deposit and issue our receipt. Any disputes arising from this contract are to be decided by the Canadian courts.

MJB WILDERNESS TREKKING LTD COMMITMENT TO YOU**HOLIDAY PRICE**

We reserve the right to alter the prices of any of the holidays shown on our website. You will be advised of the current price of your holiday that you wish to book before your contract is confirmed. When you make your booking you must pay a deposit of £250 / US\$500 per person. The balance of the price of your holiday must be paid at least 8 weeks before your departure date. In the case of non-payment of your balance by the due date, we reserve the right to cancel your booking. No discounts for unused services will be given if you choose not to take part in the full holiday as described in the trip information.

CHANGING OR CANCELLING YOUR HOLIDAY

It is in the nature of a holiday of this kind that arrangements and participants have to be flexible. The day-to-day agenda and ultimate goal of the trip are taken as aims and not as contractual obligations. It is a necessary condition of your joining any MJB Wilderness Trekking Ltd holiday that you accept this flexibility. It is unlikely that we will have to make any changes to your travel arrangements. Occasionally, we may have to make changes and we reserve the right to do so at any time. In the case of such changes there is no entitlement to cancel without penalty. If we have to make a major change to your holiday such as a change to your departure date or a lower than expected standard of accommodation resulting in a significant inconvenience with regard to your holiday, we will notify you and give you the option to cancel with a full refund. In the event that an international flight being delayed during your holiday, the individual airline policy will apply.

We also reserve the right in any circumstances to cancel your travel arrangements. For example, if the minimum number of clients required for a particular travel arrangement is not reached, we may have to cancel your trip. For this reason we strongly advise you not to purchase flights or insurance before we have sent you confirmation in writing that your trip has met minimum numbers and is guaranteed to run. If your trip does not meet minimum numbers, we will return all payments made by you, including your deposit. If, for an unforeseeable reason outside of our local agent's control, we have to cut short your holiday, no refund or compensation will be made for any unused service or feature of the holiday.

We will not pay you compensation if we have to cancel or change your travel arrangements in any way because of war, riot, industrial dispute, terrorist activity, natural or nuclear disaster, fire, adverse weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.

YOUR COMMITMENT TO MJB WILDERNESS TREKKING LTD**HOLIDAY PRICE**

When you make your booking you must pay a non-refundable deposit of US\$500 / 250 UK Pounds per person. A completed Booking Form must be received and a receipt issued by the MJB Wilderness Trekking Ltd before the booking is confirmed and the contract is made.

Upon receipt of your non-refundable deposit and booking form we will forward a confirmation invoice informing you of the date by which final payment must be made for your trip. This is normally 8 weeks before departure. You must check that your chosen holiday has reached the minimum numbers required and is guaranteed to run, before paying for your air tickets. We cannot be held liable, in cases where we cancel the tour you have booked, for any losses incurred relating to any flight booking, or any other related costs.

CANCELLING YOUR HOLIDAY

Written notification from the person who made the booking must be received by MJB Wilderness Trekking Ltd. Cancellation charges as shown below will be applicable.

Within 1 month of the departure date, cancellation charges consist of the deposit and full balance of the holiday.

Between 1 and 2 months of departure date cancellation charges consist of the deposit and 50% of total balance of the holiday.

Longer than 2 months prior to departure date cancellation charges consist of the deposit.

MJB Wilderness Trekking Ltd strongly advises that travel insurance is taken out at the time of booking which may cover any cancellation charges.

MJB WILDERNESS TREK LEADER AUTHORITY

By signing our booking form you agree to abide by the authority of the MJB Wilderness Trekking Ltd leader. All decisions of the leader are final. If the leader considers your behaviour or physical condition is detrimental to the well being of the group, or if the leader considers your own well being will be put at risk by continuing with the holiday, you may be asked to leave the trip without right to any refund for unused services.

WAIVER OF ALL CLAIMS

Upon receiving payment of your deposit MJB Wilderness Trekking Ltd will issue you with a Disclosure of Risk, Release from Liability and Waiver of all Claims Form. This form must be read carefully and understood, then signed, dated and returned to MJB Wilderness Trekking Ltd by all participants (one per form) before departing on any MJB Wilderness Trekking Ltd holiday.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS

Your passport and visa requirements are your responsibility and you should confirm these with the relevant Embassies and/or Consulates. We do not accept any responsibility if you cannot travel because you have not complied with any passport or visa requirements. Full and correct passport information is required when you make a booking, in order that we can obtain necessary permits on your behalf. If you do not supply the appropriate and correct information we will not be able to make the necessary bookings on your behalf and cannot be held responsible.

TRAVEL AND CANCELLATION INSURANCE

To take part on any MJB Wilderness Trekking Ltd holiday you must be covered by adequate insurance for the complete duration of your trip. Your insurance must include cover for; medical expenses, injury, death, cost of repatriation and helicopter evacuation. In the event of an emergency medical rescue or evacuation from a trip of you the client, either by foot, helicopter or otherwise the responsibility for the payment of such costs will lie with the client. Any subsequent costs incurred for expenses such as hotels, food, transport etc shall be borne by the client. It is imperative that the client ensures adequate insurance cover is in place before departure. We recommend that you fully understand the limits and exclusions of your policy before taking out the insurance cover. It is your responsibility to ensure that the insurance cover you purchase is adequate for the particular needs of you and your party. We do not check our client's insurance policies. We reserve the right to cancel your booking at any time before departure if we are not satisfied that adequate insurance is in place for you. All baggage and personal effects are at all times at your own risk. We will not be responsible for any loss, damage or accident to any luggage and property, howsoever incurred. You are advised to check the limitations of your insurance policy in this respect.
